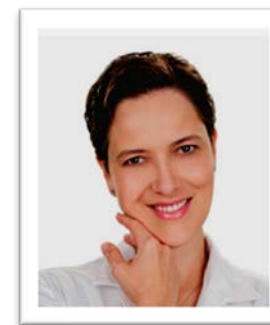
Dr. Lorraine LeGrand Westfall, is a native of Montreal & General Surgeon, practicing at the Centre hospitalier des Vallées de l'Outaouais –Pavillon Gatineau, from 1986 to 2006. Dr. LeGrand Westfall was elected to the CMPA Council in 2004, becoming a Risk Management Medical Officer in 2006. In 2011 she was appointed a Director of Regional Affairs and since taking office in 2006 has made hundreds of presentations on risk management to Canadian physicians.



Dr. Jason Pozner is certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery, and is a member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, the American Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgery and the American Society for Lasers in Medicine and Surgery. He has been a consultant or investigator for many aesthetic companies and member of several advisory boards, including Sciton, Mentor, Bioform, Coapt, Medicis, Allergan and Ultrashape. He is the founder of Sanctuary Plastic Surgery and co-owner of Sanctuary Medical Aesthetic Center in Boca Raton. Dr. Pozner is widely experienced in the latest and most effective cosmetic procedures.



Dr. Timothy M. Greco is a facial cosmetic plastic surgeon in Philadelphia PA whose aesthetic surgical practice focuses solely on plastic and reconstructive surgery of the face, head and neck. He has authored numerous papers on facial plastic surgery and teaches throughout the United States on new facial procedures and techniques. He is a key opinion leader and medical consultant for Allergan, Valeant and Merz.



Dr. Lina Triana is a plastic surgeon in Cali, Colombia specializing in aesthetic plastic surgery, liposculpture, gluteoplasty, breast surgery, labiaplasty and laser vaginal rejuvenation. She has been an invited guest lecturer worldwide and has several journal publications on her extensive experience with liposuction and labiaplasty. Dr. Triana is the past president of the Colombian Society of Plastic Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery and currently the president of the Education Council of ISAPS.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

Participants will also learn the efficacy and appropriate use of needles versus cannulas for delivery of injectables as well as rhinoplasty using injectable fillers.
