**Dr. George Bitar**, (Fairfax Virginia) is a board certified plastic surgeon, Medical Director of the Bitar Cosmetic Surgery Institute and assistant clinical professor at George Washing University School of Medicine and Health Sciences. His specialty in cosmetic surgery spans the latest surgical and minimally invasive techniques. Dr. Bitar is a specialist body contouring, especially after weight loss. He believes in minimally invasive techniques and is also a specialist in non surgical rhinoplasty and has co-authored many articles and book chapters on breast, body contour facial rejuvenation and non surgical rhinoplasty.



**Dr. Liisa Honey** (Ottawa, ON) is the Department Chief of Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Medical Director of the Maternal Newborn Program at Queensway Carleton Hospital in Ottawa. She has completed a Master's Certificate in Physician Leadership Development and more recently a Master's level course in Quality Improvement and Patient Safety. As a Physician Advisor for the CMPA Dr. Honey is experienced in providing members with support and guidance in medical-legal matters



**Dr. Sharyn Laughlin** (Dermatologist, Ottawa, ON) is an Assistant Professor in the Division of Dermatology at the University of Ottawa and on the active Attending Staff at the Ottawa Hospital. She is the medical director of Laserderm in Ottawa that is equipped with more than 25 laser/light and energy-based systems.



**Dr. Mark Lupin** (Dermatologist, Victoria BC) is a Clinical Instructor on Faculty with the Department of Dermatology and Skin Science, UBC and Director and Founder of Cosmedica Laser Centre. Not only an expert in advanced laser techniques, safety and physics, Dr. Lupin is also a world class classical violinist. He actively performs both as a soloist as well as Concert master of the World Doctors Orchestra, with all concert proceeds donated to help medical charities.



**Dr. Nancy Tucker** (Oculoplastic Surgeon, Toronto, ON) is currently assistant professor Department of Ophthalmology & Vision Sciences, University of Toronto Mount Sinai Hospital. She is recognized for her skill in surgical teaching and has given numerous presentations, lecturing extensively both nationally and internationally. Her current research interests are in the areas of endonasal DCR, and fat re-injection in blepharoplasty surgery.

### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVES**

Participants will learn and compare optimal techniques for periocular rejuvenation including TCA, Ed Filler, PRP, microneedling and discuss indications for traditional RS, C02/ erbium vs fractional technology.

Participants will also learn pearls for a successful upper eyelid blepharoplasty nanofat transfer technique for lower eyelid blepharoplasty. Registrants will compare various surgical and non surgical techniques for rhinoplasty and body contouring. Participants will review algorithms for scars, including surgical, traumatic, acne and striae. Registrants will acquire medical legal management skills following an adverse event.

Faculty and registrants are encouraged to bring cases and participate in an interactive discussion of case challenges and problems.
